

8 - ROME ILLUMINATED TREVİ FOUNTAIN - THE COLISEUM - PIAZZA VENEZIA ST. PETER'S BASILICA - PIAZZA NAVONA

Rediscover Rome in a magic atmosphere created by romantic lighting. The tour begins at Via Veneto, the "Dolce Vita" street, and continues to Piazza Barberini with the Triton Fountain by Bernini, Piazza Venezia with the "Vittoriano", Via dei Fori Imperiali, the Coliseum, the Arch of Constantine, the Palatine, the Temple of Vesta, the Theatre of Marcello, the Capitol, the Tiberine Island, the Synagogue, Castel St. Angelo, and St. Peter's Square and Basilica. During this panoramic visit of the city, the guide will take you to visit the famous Trevi Fountain and Piazza Navona, the baroque square and cosmopolitan meeting place.

10 - ANCIENT OSTIA

Add something really special to crown your Roman holidays! At only 30 min. from the capital city, an extraordinary archeological site as important and exciting as Pompeii awaits us: the impressive excavations of Ancient Ostia. This was the city-harbor founded by the ancient Romans at the mouth of the Tiber which later was hidden by floods and abandoned until present day. Its remains are thus better preserved than Rome itself and offer us an extraordinary testimonial of Roman civilization along its entire evolution. Walking through the ancient roads, we plunge into the past life of a refined and dynamic city where art and pleasure were sovereign. You will admire the ruins of majestic public buildings including temples, theatres, forums and basilicas, as well as of private ones such as houses, shops, inns, workshops and more, ranging from extravagant to the humble. Particularly attractive are the famous mosaics of the 12 thermal baths and of the various harbor offices (Corporation Square). A further bonus: archeologists protected the whole area from modern intrusion, retaining a delicious natural oasis, constantly cooled by healthy sea breezes.

11 - NAPLES - POMPEI

We'll head south, leaving Rome along the Autostrada del Sole. Halfway to Naples, the Abbey of Montecassino, completely rebuilt after the total destruction in the Second World War, can be seen high up on the hill to our left as we continue through the fertile countryside surrounding Naples. After a bit of sightseeing on the way to Pompeii, we stop for a visit at an ancient cement and coral factory in Torre del Greco. We then head on to Pompeii for lunch and a visit of the excavations. Nineteen centuries ago during the summer of 79 A.D., Vesuvius suddenly erupted, completely destroying Pompeii and Herculaneum. Its ashes, gases and hot clouds claimed numerous lives, at the same time preserving the environment and way of life typical of the ancient Roman society at its height. The layer of ashes preserved people, everyday items, food and domestic animals intact. All remained hidden until the first half of 18th century when excavations were organized. At the end of the visit we return to Rome, arriving at about 8.30 p.m.

12 - ASSISI - ORVIETO

Leaving Rome on the Autostrada del Sole as far as Orte, we reach Spoleto. We proceed to Orvieto, famous for its beautiful Cathedral (visit), and on to the Citignano springs, Trevi, Foligno, and Spello, arriving in Assisi. We visit the Church of Santa Chiara where St. Francis was born. Walking through the narrow streets we reach Piazza del Comune with the Palazzo del Priore, the Palazzo del Popolo and the Temple of Minerva. We continue to the Basilica of St. Francis with its masterpieces by Giotto and Cimabue. After lunch in a restaurant, you will have some free time. We continue by bus to the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, the place where St. Francis lived and died, with a visit to the Porziuncola Chapel. Return to Rome arriving around 7.00 pm.

1 - MONUMENTAL ROME (St. Peter's Basilica)

TREVI FOUNTAIN - PANTHEON - PIAZZA NAVONA - ST. PETER'S BASILICA
From Via Veneto, famous for Fellini's movie "La Dolce Vita," and Piazza della Repubblica with the Fountain of the Naiads, our promenade through the historical center carries us to the famous Trevi Fountain and on to Piazza Navona (stop), always lively and picturesque, with the Fountain of the Four Rivers, Bernini's masterpiece. Along the way we admire Piazza Colonna with the Column of Marcus Aurelius and the Pantheon, built in the 1st century B.C. and featuring the widest dome in the world (visit). We continue by coach to the Vatican, the heart of Christendom, passing by St. Angelo's Castle. We visit Saint Peter's Square and Saint Peter's Basilica to admire, among others, the Pietà by Michelangelo.

2 - ANCIENT ROME (The Roman Forum)

FORUM - COLOSSEUM - CAPITOL - ST. PAUL'S OUTSIDE THE WALLS
Passing the Quirinal Square including the Presidential Palace, we arrive at Piazza Venezia dominated by the imposing "Vittoriano." The tour will continue on foot through the Capitol, a unique treasure of history and art, to the Roman Forum, the most enchanting and important archaeological site in the world: the view of it from the Capitoline Hill or the Titus Arch will leave you breathless! We will then head to the Constantine Arch and the Colosseum, majestic symbol of the Eternal City (stop). Proceeding by bus, we will pass the Pyramid of Cestius on our way to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls (visit) built where the "Apostle of the People" is buried.

VATICAN MUSEUMS AND THE SISTINE CHAPEL
Crossing the Aurelian Walls and the Villa Borghese Park, we reach the Vatican Museums. During the visit you will admire: the Candelabra Gallery, the beautiful Tapestry Gallery, the interesting cartographic study in the Maps Gallery, the Raphael Rooms frescoed by the Master, and, above all, the Sistine Chapel, where the Popes are elected and where you'll find the famous Genesis and Last Judgement frescoes by Michelangelo, recently restored.

4 - CHRISTIAN ROME (The Catacombs)

ST. MARY MAJOR - HOLY STAIRS - ST. JOHN LATERAN - APPIAN WAY - CATACOMBS
Passing by Piazza Barberini with the Triton Fountain by Bernini, we reach the Basilica of St. Mary Major (visit) the most beautiful basilica dedicated to Mary the Mother of Christ, with gorgeous mosaics and the relics of Jesus' cradle. We continue to the Basilica of St. John Lateran (visit) and the first Papal residence with masterpieces from the Middle Ages to the Baroque period. Visit Holy Stairs (stop). Through the first part of the Appian Way, with a view at the Domine Quo Vadis

Chapel, we reach the Catacombs (Domitilla or St. Callistus), the ancient underground cemerities and extraordinary expression of faith of the early Christians. The tour ends with a panoramic view of the Caracalla Thermal Baths.

ROMAN FORUM - COLOSSEUM - MICHELANGELO'S MOSES

You will be taken to Piazza Venezia, where you will see the imposing memorial to Vittorio Emanuele II, the first King of Unified Italy. The tour will then proceed to the Roman Forum, the old center of the Imperial City, where the Senate House, the basilicas and the temples of the major gods are located. After walking down the Via Sacra and passing by the Arch of Titus, you will visit the Coliseum, surrounded by impressive monuments such as the ruins of the Arch of Constantine the Great. The last stop on your tour will be the 5th-century Christian basilica of St. Peter in Chains, where you will see the world famous Statue of Moses by Michelangelo.

A short drive will take us to Villa d'Este, one of the most enchanting of the late Renaissance, home of Lucretia Borgia's son, famous for its gardens, marvelous fountains, waterfalls and cenotaphy trees.

6 - ROMAN COUNTRYSIDE

This pleasant trip exploring the surroundings of Rome with its medieval towns and volcanic lakes will give you the opportunity to relax for few hours outside the city traffic. Following the Caracalla Baths and the Appian Way we reach Castel Gandolfo, summer residence of the Pope overlooking one of the deepest volcanic lakes. We continue to Albano (formerly Albalonga), legendary birthplace of Rome's founders, Ariccia with a breathtaking bridge, Genzano reputed for its flower carnival, and Nemi, the town of wild strawberries which overlooks an enchanting lake known as the "Mirror of Goddess Diana." We'll follow the Via dei Laghi to Rocca di Papa, Grottaferrata, and Frascati, where we will sit down to taste its delicious wine.
